Your application should contain:

- Name, surname, MBAG, e-mail address, cell phone number
- For undergraduate students: year of study
- For graduate students: major (in Croatian: "smjer diplomskog studija")
- Motivational letter (Croatian or English), not longer than 1 page A4 (clearly state your interest in the theme of the seminar and your existing knowledge on the subject). If you have attended elective courses given by Department of Trade or Department of Tourism, please specify which courses. If you took courses on HRM, please point it out! If you are doing your final paper or seminar in the field trade, tourism or HRM, please specify its title and mentor.

Selected candidates will be notified by e-mail on 15<sup>th</sup> April. The follow up letters to selected candidates will contain further information.
