- 4) A focus for development and application of knowledge. Excellence in manufacturing and service operations must be led by the development of **new knowledge**. The Association provides such a focus for identifying and **disseminating the latest thinking and research** as well as for exploring current issues in OM, thereby setting **research agendas for the future**.
- 5) The **International Annual EurOMA Conference** is a major forum for the presentation of new ideas and developments in the field.
- 6) Supporting **excellence in education**. EurOMA promotes and supports a wide range of academic activities designed to advance the teaching and learning of Operations Management, including **workshops, seminars, summer schools and forums**.

EurOMA History

- The Association was originally formed as a UK-based group (OMA) in **1984**, and rapidly grew into Europe's leading professional association for Operations Management.
- The expanding European dimension led to the forming of the European Operations Management Association (EurOMA) in October **1993**.
- At its annual conference in **2009** (Gothenburg), EurOMA proudly acknowledged **25 years** of OM in Europe
- In **2013** (Dublin), EurOMA celebrated the **20th anniversary** of its own annual conference.
