3. **Language Proficiency**
  - 3.1 **English**: : B2 CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), DAAD Language Certificate, TOEFL IBT 79, TOEFL PBT 550, IELTS 6 or other proof of equivalent English proficiency Native English speakers along with students who are taking their degree program in English are exempted who are taking their degree program in English are exempted
  - 3.2 **German** (only necessary if students want to take classes offered in German): B2 CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) or sufficient proof of equivalent German proficiency
