Pécs, Hungary's fifth largest city lies in the southern part of the country. The vicinity of the Adriatic, the winding streets of the historic centre, the teeming life of the early summer evenings all evoke the feeling of a Mediterranean region. At the same time, Pécs is a regional cultural and university centre. Traditions derived from its cultural heritage and from artistic innovation shape its present character. Pécs was a European Capital of Culture in 2010, and the related projects realized more long-term developments in both the city and the region.

Founded in 1367, the University of Pécs now comprises of nine University and two College Faculties including the former independent Medical University. With its ten faculties the University of Pécs plays a significant role in Hungarian higher education. The University offers a broad range of training and degree programs ensuring high-level knowledge-transfer and research. With its more than 29,000 students and nearly 2,000 teaching and research staff the impact of the University of Pécs extends well beyond the borders of the city. The Faculty of Business and Economics (FBE) was established in 1970 – and has since then become a leading centre of education and training of economists and business persons.
